There is only one thing that cannot be imitated, it cannot be personified; and that is the Word.

For that reason, the great mystery hidden in the Tent Vision cannot have imitations, cannot be personified; there will be no imitators, personifiers; because it is the Word, the Word manifesting Itself according to the divine promises.

It is that Third Pull the Word for all the children of God; it is that Word that cannot fail for all the people.

Now, we can see the Word in letter, we can hear the Word being spoken, we can see the Word when we understand that Word. When we understand it, we are seeing It, we are understanding It; that is why: “He that heareth my Word hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation, but is passed from death unto life.”

“He who hears my Word” is “he who understands my Word”; therefore, the good land is that which hears the Word and understands It; and it bears fruit a hundredfold, sixty-fold and thirty-fold.

Because when the Word is understood, then comes that blessing

to produce according to the seed of that Word, to produce what that Word has to produce, what that Word has to produce in the one who is sown; and It produces it when the person hears and understands that Word.
