There are many people who say: "I believe all the Word of God." But when you hear the Word of God, that is when you identify yourself as a believer or an unbeliever in the Word of God.

And how is someone going to say he believes the Revelation, if he does not first hear the words of the apocalyptic prophecy? How is he going to say he believes all that is written there if he doesn't even know what it means?

First one has to hear the words of the prophecy of that book, where the meaning of all that is written in Revelation is made known, and then the person will assume the position according to what is inside his heart. If what is within his heart is faith, genuine faith in God to believe all the Word of God, he will say: "This is what I was waiting for! I was waiting for the Lord to make known the meaning of all those apocalyptic symbolisms, to receive them!"

When he hears them, he says: "Now I understand the Revelation, now I understand those apocalyptic symbols, now I see; before I didn't see, I didn't understand the Revelation, before I was blind to the apocalyptic truths; because when I read, all I saw were symbols, but when I listen, when I hear the words of the prophecy of that book being brought, being brought in this end time where the meaning of all that apocalyptic revelation is made known to us, then I do see, that I understand and receive the revelation of Jesus Christ that He has sent through His Angel to testify of these things in all the churches."

This is the greatest and most glorious time for human beings, this is the time when all this apocalyptic revelation is made known; it is made known according to how the Lord Jesus Christ said it would be made known.
