the spiritual phase. If he interrupts in this spiritual phase, he cannot be in the literal phase, which is coming soon.

(...) Therefore, we can neither add to nor subtract from what Christ reveals to us for our time in the manner established for every revelation of Christ to come to His Church.

The revelation of Christ came in each age to His Church through His Holy Spirit through the messenger relevant to each age. Many who were living in the age pertaining to the time that God sent each messenger, added or removed some things that Christ revealed through the messenger. And what did they do? They damaged the Wine that God had given for that time, and could not produce the revival, the stimulus for that time.

But those who kept that Wine pure and thus served it to their congregations, and took it everywhere, the people received the stimulus of the Spirit, the stimulus of the Wine that the Holy Spirit was giving at that time, and they were blessed; and those who have already departed are in Paradise, and their messengers too, and the people who with those messengers faithfully worked in the Work of Christ. So it is also for our time.

"All revelation must always (says the Reverend William Branham) come through a prophet, because the Word, the divine revelation, only comes to the prophets." And in our time, every divine revelation has to come in the form that God has established for this end time; and we can neither remove nor add to it, but rather, we have to take advantage of time so that what God has given us passes on to our congregations as it has been given; because God for this time has given us cameras to tape all the conferences on video, He has given us tape recorders, and so on, so that the Word revealed for our time passes directly through the ears to the soul of the people, and they receive the promised stimulus for this end time.

Therefore, it is not in our best interest to take the time that belongs to the promised Word being revealed, to start talking about things or giving our own ideas.

(...) And for this end time, you see, Christ converts the Word promised for our time, makes it a reality, brings it to life, to fulfillment; and He gives us the stimulus of the new Wine, of the Word promised for this end time. And thus it stimulates our soul and our whole being; us as individuals and the entire Mystical Body of our beloved Lord Jesus Christ. He gives us the promised Word of the Latter Rain; and it turns the Water of the Latter Rain, the teaching of the Second Coming of Christ and the promises of the Second Coming of Christ, the promises of the Seventh Seal, it turns them into a stimulus for us; and it vindicates all those promises.

And now, we find that we are living in the end time, where Christ left the best Wine for this end time.

That is why we must place the water turned into wine, the divine revelation of each age in the soul of each person, so that they have the stimulus of that wine in their lives, and thus have the revival within their soul.

And the Church as Mystical Body of believers has to have that revival within her, and for that she needs the Word promised for her age, in each stage of her existence, so that She as Mystical Body of believers has the stimulus of the Water turned into Wine.

That is why we have to place the Water turned into Wine, the Word of God, vindicated, made real; the Word promised for the age in which one has to live, turned into life, into... made real, vindicated, vivified; that is the promised Word fulfilled. To give that revealed and promised Word for that time, to give it to the people, to give it to the Church of Jesus Christ.

And therefore, the Church has that stimulus, that inner revival; and each believer in Christ in that age receives that inner revival, receives the stimulus of the wine of the revealed Word for his time.

If a minister puts his own ideas, he will not produce the stimulus pertaining to his age, the people will not have the inner revival pertaining to their time; because in order to obtain the Wine of the stimulus it has to be through the Word promised for his time, revealed, being given to the people.

When a minister sets out to put his own ideas; or takes the time that belongs to that Word to be given to the people, and takes it to set out to speak to the people his own ideas, or give them an interpretation of what he thinks the Message is, what is he doing? He is interrupting the Program of God and he is interrupting the great feast of the reception of the Marriage of Christ with each individual, which is in

So on this morning may God bless us, may God keep us, and may God help us to always be stimulated, always be happy as we are; always be stimulated with the new Wine, with the revelation (which is what produces that stimulus), and then continue onwards.

Not to stumble over anything, not to be disappointed with anything, not to be discouraged by anything, but always going forward; knowing that our days here on Earth are numbered, knowing that we are not from here on Earth, but that we are from another dimension, but that we are in the flesh these days here, for a while, while our transformation comes.

So, even that, when you know that and you know that you are one of the ones that is going to be transformed and that you are being transformed spiritually first...; you are being transformed spiritually first, see? Then, as you are being transformed spiritually, you will then be transformed physically.

No one will be transformed physically unless he is first transformed spiritually. So knowing all these things, you, no matter how many struggles, no matter how many problems, no matter how many difficulties come to you as an individual, look ahead and you will have reason to be happy, to be joyful, to be stimulated.

Look at that Word of this hour, look at that new Wine and let that new Wine stimulate you; because that produces that spiritual stimulus for you not to feel defeated in life.

Job, notice Job: Job lost everything, but he did not feel defeated; he was stimulated. And when he lost his family he said¹: "God gave and God took away." He was stimulated, you see? And then after he passed his trials, the blessing was greater than what he had lost; he hadn't lost any of them, it was that he was being tested.

And we are being tested here; so you are not going to lose any blessing, you are receiving more and more blessings. And then, when we are there, we will realize why we had to go through so many struggles, so many problems, so many difficulties. And the more problems and more struggles you go through, the greater the blessing that God has for you.

So don't be complaining so much, it is that the one who is going to receive a blessing, the person that God has a great blessing for, well, the trial is greater.

Look at Job's trials, now look at the blessing. Look at Saint Paul's trials, now look at the blessing. Look at brother Branham's trials, now look at the blessing. Look at the people who haven't had trials, see what blessing they have had. You see?

Job 1:21

After death, of this last church age... Now, you notice what happened, see. After death, their dead bodies are destroyed by wild beasts. You know that. Now, that's true. Like theirs, had the type of Jezebel. / Now we notice, killed by a command of God, was Jezebel, was killed because God had Jehu to go down there and have her throwed out of the window (2 Kings 9:30-37), and kill Jezebel.
