that God is going to do with miracles, wonders and signs. Let’s also look at page... and remember that the Son of Man comes with His Angels; and what we are going to see here, page 128, paragraph 1143, it says [Quotations]¹:

“Under the Seventh Trumpet, is to Israel the same as the Seventh Seal was to the Church.” The Seventh Trumpet for Israel is the same as the Seventh Seal for the Church. Let’s look at page 129, paragraph 1149. Let’s read a little part here. It says:

“Between the—the—the Sixth, the Fifth Seal and the Sixth Seal... Between the Sixth Seal and the Seventh Seal, there was a calling out of the hundred and forty-four thousand. You remember that? Now there is where these trumpets come in right there.”

And then, paragraph 1150, says:

“And at the same time (in other words, the mystery of the Seventh Seal will be known, the Seventh Seal will be opened to the Church of the Lord)... Now, as soon as this Church (the Bride) is drawn together, She is taken up; and that mystery of the Seventh Seal, or the Seventh Seal, the mystery of going. And the Jews is called by the mystery of the Seventh Trumpet, which is two prophets, Elijah and Moses.”

And now, he places that last trumpet saying that the last trumpet as the last Seal, is the Coming of the Lord; it is that the Son of Man comes with His Angels, and if you want to see it otherwise, the Seventh Seal comes with the Seventh Trumpet: it is the greatest mystery. When on Mount Transfiguration Christ showed them the order of His Coming, there were Moses and Elijah, one on each side.

Therefore, in the Coming of the Lord to His Church, the ministries of Moses and Elijah also have to appear. On page 149, paragraph 1333:

“Remember, that, ‘They which are alive and remain shall not hinder those which are sleeping, for the Trump of God, that last Trumpet...’ The sixth one has just sounded... And that last Trumpet, like the last Seal, will be the Coming of the Lord. ‘It shall sound, and the dead in Christ shall rise first...’ Just resting till that time.”
