And let me go over here in India and try to produce and show to them the real Lord Jesus Christ with His powers, His miracles, His Baptism, everything, and the Holy Ghost.' Then when they come to Jerusalem... Brother Beeler, this was what you was asking about. When they come to Jerusalem and stand out there, and say, 'Now, if Jesus is the Son of God that raised from the dead, He knows the things just like He did back there in the beginning, He can produce the same Life that He did back there. And if He does, will you accept Him as your personal Saviour?' And then show that God by His great powers and things of His resurrected power, He's with us.
