

and we who are living, if we are not yet transformed, may be transformed; because at that stage, when the squeeze comes, that which was seen manifested in the Reverend William Branham temporarily and partially, will be seen manifested in all its fullness.

That Third Pull will be in all its fullness, and the New Name of the Lord Jesus Christ will be there. And the New Name of the Lord Jesus Christ will be glorified, as was the name He used in His First Coming:

[John 12:28] *“I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again (once more).”* And again, for it is the second time.

Now, in that Third Pull, the Reverend William Branham calls it “the Third Pull” that stage where the manifestation of God in all His fullness will be in the midst of His Church, and therefore things will happen that we didn’t even imagine would be possible. But if God has promised it in His Word, all that He has promised must be fulfilled.

For the resurrection of the dead in Christ, the Third Pull must come, and for our transformation as well. And the Eternal Name of God and the New Name of the Lord Jesus Christ comes there, who says that He will write It upon the overcomer; and that will be the one who will know the mystery of the New Name of Jesus Christ and the mystery of His Coming.

And he will be adopted; and when he is adopted then the greatest miracles and wonders in the entire history of Christianity will be seen, to such an extent that it will shake the Hebrew people; and look at what the Hebrew people are going to say: Page 22 of the book of *Quotations*, verse 176, at the end, says²:

“When the Lord Jesus shall come for His Bride, and they (that is, the Hebrews) see Him, they’ll say, ‘That’s the One we’ve waited on, there He is!’ He’ll rise with healing in His wings.”

And His wings are the ministries of Moses and Elijah. That is why the Reverend William Branham says: “The great miracles, those are under the ministries of Moses and Elijah³.”

He put poplar sticks in the water, speckled them, scare the cattle when they was pregated with the... with their young, to make speckled cattle and sheep. Nothing but a deceiver!

²⁷⁹ But one night he caught a hold of Something real, and he knowed It was real. And he stayed with It, and held on until he overcome. And his name was changed, and called Israel, meaning “a prince with power before God.”

²⁸⁰ Is that right? Every overcomer!

²⁸¹ Simon was a fisherman. But when his faith caught and knowed that was Jesus, when He told him He was the Messiah, and told him who his name was and what his father’s name was, he was overcome, and changed from Simon to Peter.

²⁸² Saul, good name. Saul, was a king one time in Israel, but he, a Saul, didn’t fit an apostle. Might be all right for a king, but not an apostle. So Jesus changed his name (from what?) from Saul to Paul. Look at “The sons of thunder,” and on down.
