Like when they invite our brothe r Bermudez, they invite him for perhaps a day in the country or perhaps for a walk, Bermudez says: "I just don't have time. I'm busy all the time doing this book work, doing this recording work, this video work, and I don't have time to go for a walk here or there..." That is good, that he doesn't have time for things that are temporary, because his time is occupied with things that are eternal.

Of those that are temporary, nothing will be obtained in the Kingdom of God: All that is lost. But those that are eternal: They go with us to the Millennium and to eternity as well; that is the time that a person makes the best use of, that is the only time that is well used; the rest, the rest of the time, is being lost.

So, the efforts of this Earth, you see, that people think are the main thing in life... what people are doing is wasting a lot of time there; they are wasting the time of their lives, when the greater time should be used in the Kingdom of God, which is the time that counts as being used to store up treasures in Heaven.

Now, there are also the riches of this world. Some people have good economic positions, and because of those positions and their businesses they are very busy making a lot of money here; but they say they have no time for the Kingdom of God. And who is harmed? They are not going to harm the Kingdom of God, they harm themselves.

You see, the man who had many possessions..., and the Lord Jesus Christ says that this man increased his storehouses and stored up many goods, and then He said¹: "Soul of mine, you have many goods; you are a rich person, a multimillionaire, you have many

goods; so be glad, rejoice, for you have many goods."

And the Lord says... and it was said to him that night: "You fool, today, tonight they come to ask for your soul; and what you have stored up, whose shall it be?" Why? Because he can't take it with him when he dies. It is then enjoyed by those who didn't work. And he who worked didn't use it for the Kingdom of God, therefore he can't take it with him; and since he can't take it with him and has nothing stored up in the Kingdom of God, "where his treasure is, there will his heart be.2"

Therefore, as his treasure was here on Earth and his heart was also here on Earth, he has nothing to go to seek in the Kingdom of God. He has nothing there; therefore, he can't go there. He died and can't go to the sixth dimension, to Paradise, because he didn't store anything in the Kingdom of God, so he has nothing to go there to look for.

And so it happens with people who are represented as places where what is born are thorns and things like that.

Now, you see, material goods and the cares of this life are represented (in what?) in the thorns or thorns that affect the person so that the Word that was sown in him may produce fruit.

That is why we must always understand that the Lord said, when asked what the first commandment is, He said³: "Hear, O Israel; the Lord your God is one. And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy soul, with all thy mind, with all thy strength." That means: God first.

So in the life of each of us, adults, youth and children: God is first.

Now, notice, we already have here three different groups of people, in whom the Word was sown, but the Word was placed but it didn't produce anything. To some it produced joy, but then they became afraid when the trials came upon them. To these other ones, you see, those who were sown among thorns: The Word was sown, there it was born, it also grew, but it bore no fruit.

But here we have the fourth group⁴:

"But he that received seed into the good ground is he that

heareth the word, and understandeth it (the others heard it but didn't understand it); which also beareth fruit (in order to bear fruit one must hear and understand the Word; the others heard it and didn't bear fruit), and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty."
