Now this, from the time, these martyrs are the true Orthodox Jews that died in Christian faith... or in—in religious faith, because they could not be Christians.

¹¹⁵ Remember, God blinded their eyes. And they're going to be blind for a long time, until the Gentile Church is taken out of the way. Cause, God doesn't deal with them two people at the same time, because it's very contrary to His Word.

¹¹⁶ Remember, He deals with Israel as a nation, always. It's the nation of Israel.
