overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world."

There we can see that there are names written in the Lamb's Book of Life, which, when those people are manifested on Earth, they will not worship the beast, and will remain faithful to Christ.

Those are the people who receive Christ as their Savior, wash their sins in the Blood of Christ and are baptized in water in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ: and they receive the Holy Spirit, and obtain the new birth, they are born of Heaven.

Also in chapter 17 of the book of Revelation it speaks again of the people who will not worship the beast, and shows us that they will be those whose names are written in the Book of Life. Chapter 17, verse 8, says:

"The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is."

And now, again we find that there are names written in the Book of Life, that will not worship the beast; those people, when manifested on Earth, are the people who receive Christ as their Savior in the time they live, and are the people who remain faithful to Christ our Savior, are the people who belong to that mighty Army of the white horse Rider of Revelation 19, verses 11 to 21, and Revelation, chapter 17, verses 14 to 15.
