Sun of Righteousness: The ministry of Moses and Elijah in the Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ. He spoke of this Angel when he spoke these things.

And we also find that Saint Paul spoke of this Angel when he said that the Last Trumpet would be sounded. It is always sounded by an angel messenger. He spoke of the Last Trumpet; and when speaking of the Last Trumpet, it can only be sounded by the messenger, the last Angel, that God sends for His people.

We also find that other messengers, other prophets, spoke of him. The Lord Jesus Christ Himself spoke of him when He said: "And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect." And also in the parable of the wheat and the tares, where He spoke of the Angels that would be sent at the end of the world or end of time. And he also spoke in the parable of the net, where He said that this is how it will be at the end of the world: The Angels will do that work of separating the good from the bad, or the bad from the good: the fish that were not good were separated and cast back into the water; and the good: cast into baskets, into baskets.

## SEEING THE LORD, THE ANGEL OF THE COVENANT, MANIFESTED

The Old Testament Church is the Hebrew people, and the New Testament Church is the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ. The manifestation of the Lord, the Angel of the Covenant, is always in His House, in His Family, in His Church, there in the Old Testament, and then in the New Testament in the midst of Christianity, His Church under the New Covenant.

We have also seen Him in Saint Paul and in different messengers that He has sent to His Church. We saw Him manifested in a very great form in the messenger of the seventh stage of the Church, which corresponds to the stage represented in the church of Laodicea in Asia Minor; a stage that was fulfilled in North America and that covered a multitude of nations.

We saw Him manifested, we saw Him at work, through a veil of flesh named William Branham; that was the greatest man North America had since North America was founded: a man with the two consciousnesses together, who could see God, could see the Angel of God, could talk to Him and could be His instrument.

Through him, God in His Angel was manifesting Himself, in a body of flesh called William Branham. It was God speaking through him, working through him; it was the Lord, the Angel of the Covenant, manifested through a veil of flesh, as He had done through Saint Peter and through Saint Paul as well.

Saint Paul said: "It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me." It was Christ in Saint Paul, it was God through His angelic body manifesting Himself through Saint Paul.

And now, we have seen the Lord, the Angel of the Covenant, manifested.

For this end time we have the promise that He will manifest Himself again; for which He will be veiling Himself in human flesh, and through human flesh He will reveal Himself to His Church and to the Hebrew people.

This will be seen by the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ, which is under the New Covenant, and will also be seen by the Hebrew people; and (to be more direct) the Jews, as all Hebrews are commonly called. Although it mainly refers to the southern kingdom, headed by Judah; and the northern tribes are known as Israel, they are the tribes called Israel, which are called the lost tribes of Israel, of which Jesus Christ said that He has come for the lost sheep of Israel, which are the descendants of the ten tribes.

#### BACK TO ETERNAL LIFE

In theophany, this Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ, ministered to John the apocalyptic revelation from the Lord Jesus Christ. For that reason this Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ could say as Jesus once said: "Before Abraham was, I am. And Abraham desired to see my day, he saw it and was glad."

He could say, the Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ: "Before John went in his ministry, I am. And John desired to see my day..." He desired it. He desired not only to see his day, but he also desired his position; when John and James said: "We desire that in Your Kingdom one be on Your right and the other on Your left."

"John desired to see my day; he saw it, and fell down at the feet to worship; and he was told: 'See that you do not do this, for I am a servant with you and with your brothers; worship God.' He desired to see my day; he saw it and was glad." And he also wanted to worship; because he saw the revelation of Jesus Christ in His Angel Messenger, and he saw that he had the Title Deed, and that the manifestation of this Angel with the Title Deed, for our return to eternal life, would be at the end of the world.

John and the others spoke of this Angel. Not only John the beloved disciple in the apocalyptic revelation, but also the prophet Malachi when he said that the Sun of Righteousness would be born and in His Wings would bring health. There we can see the ministry of the Angel of the Lord Jesus Christ as the two powerful Wings of the
