going to blame all of us; because the Bride, if she is not prepared for the rapture, she does not leave. And if the Bride is not ready, it is because she has not been preached to what she should have been preached. And if it has not been preached to her, it is because the Bride has not cried out to the Lord for God to give her what He has to give.

Therefore, we all bear the blame; both the congregation and the ministers. So the congregations, by not crying out to the Lord desperately to give us what we lack, then the Lord has not been able to give His ministers what He had to give them. And if anyone knew something, he kept quiet, afraid that, when he said it, the people, not being prepared, would stumble and leave.

But we have already come to a time when God has begun to reveal to His people all that He wants to reveal. He has begun and will continue.

Therefore, be prepared. Do not stumble on anything. Cry out to the Lord, pray to the Lord, so that you will be prepared; and pray to the Lord so that the Lord will continue to give us all that He wants to give us.

Because He is going to give us everything we need; and everything will be so simple that we will be amazed, as we have been amazed at the things God has already given us. Everything is so very simple. Everything is so very simple.

The Bride needs to know all that has been revealed. The Bride will know how to make contact with the other dimension, the Bride will know all those secrets.

And now, many times we care more for our body than for our soul; for example, we feed our body with literal food; but our spirit and soul cannot be fed with bread, with meat and with other things.

"Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God." The Word of God is the food for the soul of the human being. If he does not receive this Food, the person dies spiritually. He becomes spiritually sick, he loses faith in God and divine things; and when he least expects it, he says: "I do not believe in God, I do not know if He exists or not." Why? Because he was not fed with the Word of God, which is the one that contains those Vitamins, that Food, so that the person has that faith in God; because "faith comes by hearing the Word of God."

A person who does not hear and does not read the Word of God: his faith is dead, his faith dies.

With the Word of God comes faith; without the Word, well, faith (the little faith the person may have) goes away.

He is the Word. When we eat the Word by believing in Him, we are eating Christ—in spiritual terms—as Food for our soul.

For example, for the age, different ages, for a past age (fourth or

fifth age), spiritual food may be represented in rabbits; for another age it may be represented in chickens; all that is very good; but for this end time it is represented in squirrels, which were created by God and were hunted and were used as food.

Each thing, each stage, and the food of each stage, is represented in something. And if it sounds strange to anyone that it is represented like that: Well, and when you sit at the table at noon or in the evening, don't they put a piece of chicken or goat or beef? So, those physical things are type and figure of spiritual food. It is as simple as that.

So being that our age is also represented in an Eagle Age, believers are represented in eagles (see?), then the food for the eagles is represented in squirrels created by God, squirrels of which they eat.

And if the things that were revealed to me from the Lord, if I tried to keep them to myself and not make them known to you, then I am taking the Bread of the children and eating it all myself, and leaving the children to die of hunger; because we are like a family.

And the prophet says: "The shepherd is the Father of the Family." That is why it says that the Lord appointed the Father of the Family to give the necessary Food to His children. And blessed is that servant when his Lord comes and finds him doing so: feeding all in the House with the Word of God.

If I were to take the Bread that corresponds to this whole Family, to this whole House, if I were to take it for myself only: Only I would be spiritually fat, and you would be all skinny, full of spiritual anemia, and without courage to serve the Lord; and when the time of the transformation and the rapture would come, you would not be prepared.

But there is also a sentence for everyone who when his Lord comes will not find him doing as he ought to do; there is a sentence. It says: "And he shall appoint his portion with the hypocrites, and there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

In other words, there is blessing for the one who feeds His Family with all the Word for the hour, but there is also Word of judgment for the one who does not want to give all the Word in His House to the

congregation, to the children of God; because when the children of God do not receive all the necessary food: they cannot grow. And we are growing spiritually, until we reach the stature of a perfect man.

(...) Therefore, at this time, as in the time of the apostles, we are beginning a new dispensation. They had the beginning of a new dispensation and for them it was hard: they had persecutions and trials from all sides.

And you think it will not be hard for us? Yes, it will be hard too, because the beginning of a new dispensation always clashes with the dispensation that has already passed.

(...) The prophet says: "We are making a change of dispensation." There you have it, a change of dispensation.

Now, when one dispensation has ended and another one begins, that dispensation that begins is not belittling that dispensation that ended, no sir. It is the same plan that began in the first dispensation, that continues to develop in the second, and continues to develop in the third, until reaching the total perfection of the Plan that God has; because God is perfected in three.

And God's Plan was determined to be carried out in three dispensations: beginning with the Law and continuing with Grace, until reaching this third dispensation where we are in the Reclamation.

- (...) Therefore, knowing that we are in this final hour and that the rapture is waiting for the Bride, many times we think and say that we are waiting for the Lord to take us; when really what is happening is that the Lord is waiting for us, for us to reach perfection, for Him to take us from here.
- (...) Know that the devil tries to use whoever lets himself be used by him. And even if a chosen one, whether he is a brother or sister of the congregation, or a pastor, or a minister, or whoever: if he lets himself be used, the devil will use him.

And the devil will always try to use the one who lets himself be used, for what? To interrupt the Plan of God, to prevent that what should be done be done, and that the people know what they should know; because the Bride has to know the whole Word of God.

(...) Someday we will leave here; and when we leave here, then we will see how necessary it was that the whole Word of God be preached to us. And we will also see that if we had to stay here for a few years, it was because not everything we needed had been preached to us.
