So every trace of imperfection is going to disappear. And when one says ‘every trace of imperfection,’ it is every trace of imperfection. So we are very close to that.

That is why we shouldn’t be begging anyone; that is why we don’t beg neither those who are here nor those who are outside. It is a Message for all, and each one receives it, if he wants to receive it; and if he doesn’t want to receive it, he doesn’t receive it.

He who receives it, look, what he is assuring is his transformation, his eternal life, his eternal youth, all those things. He who despises it, look, he is despising all the blessings that God is offering him.

So there is no need to force anyone. Each person is responsible for themselves. So let each person assume his responsibility and don’t say: “I am not going because of So-and-so.” Rather: We are in the activity

because of the divine promises that are here in the Scripture, and not because someone forces us to go, or makes us stumble so that we don’t go.

Look, here it is not a matter of looking at other people, but look at yourself; and look at what the Scripture says; and look at the Message, the Great Voice of Trumpet, and walk forward. Help whoever you can help, and he who lets himself be helped. He who will not let himself be helped, then don’t sweat it, but pray for him; and when he needs it, help him; give him of the booklets to read as well; but remember: the responsibility is individual.

And if another stumbles, don’t stumble. You can’t afford to miss the transformation, which is very near. We don’t know if it will be in this generation. I wish it to be in this very generation. So you will take a rest from me, and I will take a rest from you, from this situation of mortal bodies, corruptible bodies, full of so many problems.

And we will pass to another stage all together, to a higher stage than this one we are in; where I will look at you and I will not see a single fault in you. Although I, when I look at you, I see no fault in you, because I look through the Sacrifice that was made on Calvary’s Cross, and I look at you through the Scripture that says that the elect will be gathered with the Great Voice of Trumpet.
