And that will be what God will quicken, what God will bring to life, what God will fulfill, what God will materialize. That will be the Word that will prosper in all that God sent it for.

We are in the time for these things to be fulfilled. And those who will be prepared: They will see them, they will receive them, they will believe them, and they will be transformed and taken with Christ to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

That is why it is important that each person has at least the book of *The Seven Seals* preached by the Reverend William Branham, and the book of *The Seven Church Ages*, the book also of *The Seventieth Week of Daniel*, and the book of *Quotations*, of excerpts from different messages of the Reverend William Branham; and all other messages that you can get in booklets that are always available for the believers in Christ; because that is the Message that prepares us to be ready for the Coming of the Lord, and to welcome Him in the midst of His Church.

It is the Message that tells how He is going to come, that prepares us to welcome the Lord in His Second Coming. It is the Message like that of John, which introduced Christ in His First Coming; for it was the ministry of Elijah being repeated in John the Baptist. And the ministry of Elijah being repeated in the Reverend William Branham for the fourth time, is the one that introduces the Second Coming of Christ, his Message.

THE ETERNAL ONE

We have already had six dispensational messengers: Adam, Seth, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Jesus, and we are missing the seventh, who will also be a dispensational prophet like Moses, who was a dispensational prophet.

That is why Israel is waiting for a prophet like Moses, and they are also waiting for a prophet like Elijah, proclaiming everlasting peace. And they know what that prophet who will be like Elijah will be talking about, will be doing, and they know what that prophet who will be like Moses will be doing.

All that is wrapped up in the mystery of the Seventh Seal, the mystery of the Second Coming of Christ, who comes with His Angels, which are the Two Olive Trees, the ministries of Moses and Elijah, according to Revelation, chapter 11, verses 1 to 14 and Zechariah, chapter 4, verses 11 to 14. Therein lies the mystery of the Seventh Seal, therein lies the mystery of the Second Coming of Christ with His Angels.

(...) And that ministry of Elijah in order to deal with the Hebrew people will come manifested by the Holy Spirit for the fifth time, and Elijah will come accompanied by Moses. And we can't explain much so that there is no imitation of fanatics who want to do something believing that they will be doing it right, and they will be interrupting God's Program.

But the time will come when God will open the mystery of the Seventh Seal, and then all will know that mystery of the Coming of the Son of Man with His Angels in the midst of Christianity.

It says: "*And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect.*" The Angels are the ministries of Moses and Elijah, and the elect are 144,000 Hebrews, 12,000 from each tribe.

In other words, those ministries will operate in favor of Israel for the restoration of the tribes of Israel, for their unification, as that ministry of Elijah the Tishbite worked there for the restoration of the ten northern tribes to the faith in the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; because they had gone astray,

and were worshiping images and were worshiping Baal and other foreign gods, Asherah and other gods.

The challenge in this end time will be on Mount Zion, just as it was there on Mount Carmel, and just as there also was on Mount Transfiguration, where Moses and Elijah appeared, one on each side, and there is the order of the Second Coming of Christ.

(...) It is important to understand these mysteries of the Kingdom of God, because these are the things that will give faith to the believers in Christ to be transformed and taken with Christ to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

And Reverend William Branham said that the Third Pull will be the one that will give the faith for the rapture to the believers in Christ, and that the faith for the rapture will be given by the Thunders; and the Thunders are the manifestation of the Third Pull, where the Voice of Christ will be speaking to His Church consecutively. Just as He spoke during the seven stages or Church ages (but not consecutively), He will speak after the seven Church ages, in the Golden Age of the Church; He will speak consecutively, He will speak as Lion, as King of kings and Lord of lords in His Reclaiming Work.

And all this will reach its culminating part in the fulfillment of the Third Pull, which will be in a Great Tent Cathedral that the Reverend William Branham said, and that he wanted to bring to fulfillment that Vision, but he wasn't granted that wish; but he said that it would be as it was shown and as it was spoken.

(...) Therefore, we are in the most glorious time of all times, where the Eternal One will have the greatest manifestation He has ever had in the midst of His Church and in the midst of the Hebrew people.

It will be a full manifestation, of which the Reverend William Branham said, "What you have seen in part..." In other words, those powerful manifestations of God speaking —Reverend William Branham anointed by the Holy Spirit—, and things coming into existence, being created by the spoken Word, as God also spoke for the creation of the universe; he says, "These things which you have seen in part manifested, shall be manifested in all their fullness."

In other words, that was the sample of what God will do in this end time; and that will be in the fulfillment of the Third Pull, which will be in a Great Tent Cathedral.

Therefore, in the midst of Christianity there will be a Great Tent Cathedral; and above all, in the midst of the group that corresponds to the time of the Golden Age of the Church, the Age of the Cornerstone; because already the seventh age, the Pentecostal age, God has already done what He was going to do, but from that manifestation that is coming He will impact the elect that are written in Heaven, in the Lamb's Book of Life, and He will give them the faith to be transformed and raptured; and that manifestation will work for the

foolish virgins also, and will give them strength so that they can pass through that stage of great tribulation and give their lives in the great tribulation as martyrs; and it will also work for mankind: mankind will be impacted and shook by that powerful manifestation of God in the Last Day; and it will also impact the Jews.

Reverend William Branham says: "When they see Christ coming for His Church, they will say, 'This is the one we are waiting for.' But He is not coming for them, He is coming for His Church." (Page 22 of the book of *Quotations*, and page 23).¹

It is going to be a manifestation so great that never in the history of mankind has ever occurred; but he says: "For that time there will be no more opportunity: Christ will have already come out of the Throne of Intercession and will have taken the Title Deed, the Book sealed with seven seals of Revelation, chapter 5, and will come to claim all that He has redeemed with His Blood."

(...) So something big is coming. Reverend William Branham says that when we see..., when Gabriel or Michael is seen on Earth, something great is about to happen; like when he appeared to the priest Zechariah and then appeared to the virgin Mary, something great was about to happen, and it was the First Coming of Christ and the coming of the forerunner John the Baptist.

And Reverend William Branham says: "Gabriel announced the First Coming of Christ, and he will announce the Second Coming of Christ."

We already saw how he announced it two thousand years ago. Let us be alert to how he will announce it, how he will announce the Second Coming of Christ. Let us be prepared because everything will be simple, says Reverend William Branham; it will be God in simplicity.

Therefore, let us be prepared, aware that something great is going to happen; and that is what is promised for the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ; and it will shake the whole world.

That is what the Reverend William Branham speaks to us about, and he says that when the squeeze comes, a squeeze that will come against the believers in Christ, against the Church-Bride of Christ, then that mighty manifestation of God will come. And he says: "It will be all parallel in everything to what was there at the First Coming and the forerunner of the First Coming" and all those things. That will be – that of this end time will be parallel to what happened two thousand years ago.

Notice, there was a forerunner for the First Coming of Christ; and a forerunner for the Second Coming of Christ has already come: Reverend William Branham with the spirit and power of Elijah in his fourth manifestation. So something great is about to happen.

In the days of John the Baptist they mocked him, they didn't believe;
